*“Brojid and Bae, you belong to God, so keep away from all these evil things. **TRY YOUR BEST TO PLEASE GOD AND TO BE LIKE HIM.** Be faithful, loving, dependable, and gentle. (1Tim 6:11 CEV Emphasis mine)*

5 Killing the Desire for Sex

First point I want you to notice is that it's possible for people's body to control them. That's why you find church people get unwanted pregnancy and pastors give church members *belle*.

Perhaps there are even tongue talking Christians who are controlled by their bodies. I do not judge them, but many of them have resigned to that situation, thinking that they can't do anything about it.

What a pity!

Some in their failure have been teaching heresy, excusing the sin that is clearly condemned in the Scriptures. But we must never join them! Instead of joining them, we shall “*Kill every desire for the wrong kind of sex...*”

We may not know all that is required to execute this killing for now; but one truth you should know very clearly is that it can be killed. Our duty is to find the means of doing it and work at it until we have succeeded.



There are many things we can do to put to death the desire for the wrong kind of sex; but for now, I want to suggest a few we must do with immediate effect.

Sex doesn't just happen. It's a product of certain factors but the engine is essentially the mind. The only sex that may not have started from the mind is the one of a rape victim. It's endured; not enjoyed!

That's why we must be careful about what we feed our minds with. Yes, we can't just read anything, listen to any conversation and watch any movie. We must fight any words, thoughts and actions that deposit the seed of sex in our heart.

At some point in my life, I had to stop seeing *oyibo* movies because of the degree of nudity littered in their movies. As much as I love music which is still my primary means of getting entertainment, I desist from listening to any song that has suggestively dirty language in it.

My reason is very simple: it is foolishness to fire up my urge for sex and expect not to be consumed by it.

Even in our discussion, we have a duty to keep it clean. Don't hesitate to call my attention to stop any line of discussion that plants in your mind craving for sex. If there is any body contact at all from me that plants the desire for sex in you instead of killing it, let me know so that there won't be a repeat of it.

When we crack jokes, it shouldn't be titled towards sex again. No more to jokes that get us feeling horny when we cannot possibly give it expression now. Therefore, next time we feel tempted to go in that direction, please restrain yourself. Baby, believe me I will do likewise.

I understand that such jokes, songs, conversations and movies can hardly drive you to grab me and start pressuring me for sex; but the thing about them is that their effect is very subtle.

Their powerful effects become reality after they have accumulated.

Please understand that once your mind is primed for sex by virtue of conversations, visuals and sounds, what is supposed to be casual will get you turned on.

That's why setting boundaries for each other is not enough. We have to ensure we don't condition our minds and body to break those boundaries.

Let's Converse for Chastity

Again, I have found that the temptation for unwholesome conversation and indiscriminate body contact gets stronger when we meet *just to see* because we are missing each other than when we meet with an agenda in mind.

That's why I suggest that the last time it happened is the last it should ever happen, at least while we are still single.

Our meeting should as a matter of responsibility be motivated by something important that can't be discussed through chat or phone conversation.

No doubt, we can meet to catch up and so I will take time to look at your eye balls, but that will only be in any of our usual public meeting points.

Our meetings and long calls shall be agenda driven. That way, idle conversations, holding hand and angle 35° hugging will be stifled out.



We won't have time for conversations that fire up our urge for sex. Right now, I'm drawing up discussion points and by God's power, I will direct our conversations so that it's focused on useful issues not mere conversation.

Our focus shall be ensuring that our conversations enrich us, revitalize us and spur us to become better and take actions for our better future.

We must cease from tempting each other in every way possible.

PS: Our quest for chastity requires our mutual efforts. We shall help each other stand firm and honour God with our bodies.
